Art Terms/Términos de Arte

This is where we begin when we learn to draw. Line can be used to draw the edge or contour of an object. Lines used to draw objects found in nature are often full of curves. Lines used to draw objects like boxes and buildings can look more mechanical, without the expressiveness of nature.


Drawing with Line

A great way to begin to draw with line is to practice drawing the edges (contours) of objects. The shapes you see when looking at the leaves, stems, and branches of plants give you a variety of contours to draw. The expressiveness of the lines you draw can increase by making them thicker or thinner, lighter or darker.



Tip/Consejo

These contour line drawings emphasize the contrast and expressiveness using thick and thin, and light and dark lines. Darker and thicker lines can be placed on the shadow side.





Example/Ejemplo

The following drawings show expressive use of line for plant drawings. Notice that the drawings focus on the outer edges (contours) and use thick and thin, and light and dark lines.
